TO THE HONORABLE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BERRIEN COUNTY, MICHIGAN: Your County Administration Committee respectfully recommends the adoption of the following:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, on November 12, 2020, the Berrien County Board of Commissioners authorized a speed limit study on Maiden Lane from Hollywood Road to Niles Road (M-63), at the request of Royalton Township; and

WHEREAS, on March 11, 2021, the Berrien County Board of Commissioners authorized a speed limit study on Maiden Lane from Washington Avenue to Niles Road, at the request of St. Joseph Charter Township; and

WHEREAS, a traffic engineering study has been conducted by the Berrien County Road Department and the Michigan State Police on Maiden Lane from Washington Avenue to Niles Road (M-63); and


WHEREAS, Traffic Control Order S 11-12-21 has been issued by the Michigan State Police stating that it has been determined from this study that a reasonable and safe speed limit on Maiden Lane from Washington Avenue to Niles Road, is 45 miles per hour (MPH) and rescinds the previous traffic control order, S 11-280-89.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Berrien County Board of Commissioners hereby sets the speed limit on Maiden Lane, in the Townships of St. Joseph Charter and Royalton, to 45 MPH between Washington Avenue and Niles Road (M-63) and authorizes the Road Department Director to sign Traffic Control Order No. S 11-12-21 establishing the speed limit, as aforementioned in this resolution, and directs the Road Department to remove any other speed limit signs.
