

TO THE HONORABLE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BERRIEN COUNTY: Your County Personnel and Human Services Committee respectfully recommends the adoption of the following:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Michigan Department of Health & Human Services (MDHHS) desires to amend the Local Health Department Comprehensive Agreement (previously known as "CPBC") for Fiscal Year 2019-2020 with the Berrien County Health Department (BCHD), with the original agreement approved under Resolution P1907265; and

WHEREAS, this agreement ensures the provision of public health services in accordance with the Michigan Public Health Code (P.A. 368 of 1978) and MDHHS policies and protocols; and

WHEREAS, this amendment reflects new funding for the Nurse Family Partnership Program, Emergency Preparedness, and COVID-19 response. The COVID-19 funding has been designated to support ongoing pandemic response activities such as COVID positive case investigations, contact tracing, and infection prevention and the potential need for FEMA local match coverage for the Isolation & Quarantine of homeless individuals; funding is approved for and will be used to support these essential department functions through personnel costs (salary & fringe), supplies, technology, and equipment needs.

WHEREAS, this amendment reflects additional funding of \$322,760 under Epi Lab Capacity COVID-19 Contact Tracing Coordination, \$20,000 under Epi Lab Capacity COVID-19 Infection Prevention, \$148,000 under PHEP COVID-19 Response, \$32,525 under Emergency Preparedness, and \$99,499 under the Nurse Family Partnership Program; and

WHEREAS, MDHHS requires that this amendment to the Comprehensive Agreement for FY 2019-20, if accepted, be executed through the authorized electronic signature of BCHD Health Officer/Director.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Berrien County Board of Commissioners accepts this amendment to the Comprehensive Agreement FY 2019-20 for a new contract total of \$4,173,552.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Berrien County Board of Commissioners authorizes and BCHD's Health Officer/Director to electronically sign or execute Amendment V to the Comprehensive Agreement FY 2019-20, as prescribed by the MDHHS.
