

**TO THE HONORABLE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BERRIEN COUNTY:** Your County Administration Committee respectfully recommends the adoption of the following:

**RESOLUTION**

**WHEREAS**, Public Act 325 of 2018 provides for the classification of all public roads, streets and highways in this state and created the State of Michigan Transportation Asset Management Council in order to provide a coordinated, unified effort by the various road agencies within this state; and

**WHEREAS**, as a part of this process, the Berrien County Road Department is required to report yearly projects in an asset management format to the State of Michigan Transportation Asset Management Council; and

**WHEREAS**, Public Act 325 of 2018 requires that the Road Department's submission of their asset management plan must include the following requirements:

- Asset inventory, including the location, material, size, and condition of the assets, in a format that allows for and encourages digital mapping.
- Performance goals, including the desired condition and performance of the assets, which shall be set by the local road agency.
- Anticipated revenues and expenses, including a description of all revenue sources and anticipated receipts for the period covered by repair and replacement expenditures, including planned improvements and capital reconstruction.
- Risk of failure analysis, including the probability and criticality of a failure of the most critical assets.
- Performance outcomes, including a determination of how the local road agency's investment strategy will achieve the desired levels of service and performance goals.
- Proof of acceptance, certification, or adoption by the local road agency's governing body; and

**WHEREAS**, as required by statute, the Berrien County Road Department developed the Asset Management Plan which drives the 3-year construction decisions in order to reach the goal of getting 75% of the primary road system in Berrien County in fair or good condition by 2029, which was approved by the Board of Commissioners via resolution A1902156 on February 14, 2019; and

**WHEREAS**, the Road Department has now developed the Bridge Asset Management Plan, the annual planning document to help guide 3-year construction decisions in order to reach the goal of getting 90% of the bridge structure system in Berrien County in fair or good condition by 2026.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED** that the Berrien County Board of Commissioners approves the 2020 Bridge Asset Management Plan for the Berrien County Road Department and authorizes the submission of the plan to the State of Michigan Transportation Asset Management Council per Public Act 325 of 2018.
