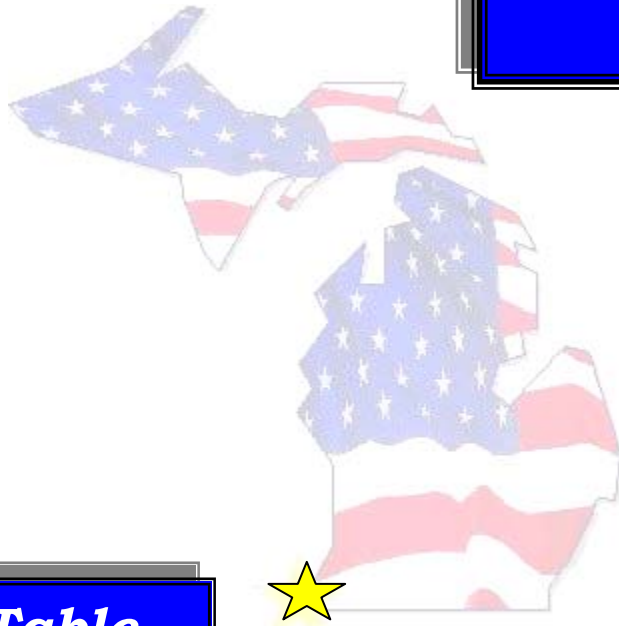

NARRATIVE PROFILE

History

Located within St. Joseph Township, The Village of Shoreham was incorporated on April 7, 1930, by William Decker. The first Village Council meeting was held on May 29, 1930. One year after incorporation, William H. Halling was appointed as Shoreham's first Deputy Sheriff. The very first building permit was issued in November 1932.

The Village of Shoreham quickly began to develop into a quiet, attractive, upper-class community. In the late 1950's, many adjacent property owners requested annexation and were incorporated into the village. Today the community is almost completely residential with the villagers committed to keeping it a foremost area in which to live.

Observations

The Village of Shoreham, which currently covers 0.56 square miles, is a small, attractive community. It is almost completely residential, with one eating establishment and several small offices. The community enjoys a low crime rate and has organized its own Neighborhood Watch program. The Village of Shoreham utilizes the police and fire departments of St. Joseph Charter Township. Sewer and water services are provided through the Lake Michigan Shoreline Water & Sewage Treatment Authority.

The Village has its own park which is considered very reclusive and for the use of villagers only. Shoreham's residents take much pride in their village and try hard to keep their community an attractive place in which to live. The village roads are well taken care of and intersections are accented by beautiful hanging gaslights. Although Shoreham borders on Lake Michigan, it does not have public access to the shoreline within the Village. The nearest access to the lake is a few miles north of the Village in the City of St. Joseph.

Community Vision

In the next two decades, the community would like to:

- A. Maintain the quiet suburban atmosphere in the Village.
- B. Continue to improve facilities in the Village Park.
- C. Retain the current low village tax rate.

Agenda of the Community Strategic Plan

The Village of Shoreham Future Land Use Plan Amendment, adopted in July 1996, lists the following Development Goals and Policies.

General Growth and Development

- Planning should provide for harmonious relationships of development within the Village.
- Planning and development should give consideration to and coordinate Village development with that of St. Joseph and Lincoln Townships and the City of St. Joseph.
- Planning should attempt to control scattering and dispersion of development so those fragile and scenic environments such as the shoreline area and the Hickory Creek ravine area will be preserved.
- Planning should protect and conserve the Village's land and natural resources and consider all environmental limitations to future development.
- Planning should establish an ideal level or range of population for the Village and plan for the accommodation of the population.
- Planning should be aware of and coordinate future development with existing land use patterns and conditions.
- Planning should seek to eliminate or reduce the effects of incompatible land use within the Village where such incompatibility exists.
- Planning should provide for the protection of environmental quality including air, water, space and noise quality.

Residential Development

- Planning should provide for balanced, efficient and attractive residential neighborhoods in the Village of Shoreham that provide, within desirable limits, a variety of housing types, adequate open space and recreation facilities, and access to employment, retail areas, and community facilities.
- Planning should consider the housing preferences of the Village's residents as well as expected residents in terms of density, location, environment and housing types.
- Planning should consider and encourage the preservation and adequate maintenance of existing residential neighborhoods in the Village

Non-Residential Development

- Planning may accommodate limited non-residential uses in the Village but only if it can be demonstrated that such uses are not substantially incompatible with adjacent contiguous properties and do not detract from the rural-residential character of development which presently exists in the Village.

Open Space and Shoreline Areas

- Planning should serve to protect the Hickory Creek floodplain and wetland area, the high-risk erosion area of the shoreline, and any other unique natural resources from development encroachment.
- Planning should attempt to achieve environmental/developmental balance within the shoreline area, protect the shoreline, and minimize real and personal property loss and damage caused by erosion, through proper zoning restrictions and performance controls.
- The Village should consider the provision, through the promotion of the Farmland and Open Space Preservation Act, or similar approach, of property tax relief for shoreline areas that are protected or preserved through local land use planning zoning, and consider state reimbursement of tax loss to local governmental units.
- The Village should provide for thorough site plan review of all new or refurbished structures in the high-risk erosion shoreline area.

The Village should, in accordance with DNR requirements and recommendations, provide for thorough review of all shoreline erosion control devices prior to construction.
