RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Michigan State Police/Emergency Management and Homeland Security Division (MSP/EMHSD) has received notice that the Hazardous Materials Emergency Preparedness (HMEP) grant will be authorized for the FY 2021-2022, and funding is being made available to all Local Emergency Planning Committees (LEPC) in the state; and


WHEREAS, grant funding emphasizes the completion of SARA Title III, Section 302, off-site emergency response plans for fixed facilities and transportation and provides support for the ongoing operations of the LEPC; and

WHEREAS, all LEPC's are eligible for support grants of at least \$3,500 through this funding source, and


WHEREAS, interested parties must submit an application no later than February 28, 2022.


