

TO THE HONORABLE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BERRIEN COUNTY, MICHIGAN: your County Administration Committee respectfully recommends adoption of the following:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the County of Berrien desires to enter into an Agreement with Flock Group, Inc. for placement of twenty (20) Flock Safety Falcon cameras in various locations in the County of Berrien for a pilot period of sixty (60) days.


WHEREAS, Flock Group, Inc. would grant the Berrien County Sheriff's Office personnel access to existing cameras, the twenty (20) pilot program cameras, and Flock Group, Inc. hardware in order to create, view, search, and archive footage and receive notifications, including those from non-agency users of the Flock Service (where there is an investigative or bona fide lawful purpose) such as schools, neighborhoods, homeowner associations, businesses, and individual users; and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff has agreed to enter into the Agreement with Flock Group, Inc. for a sixty (60) day pilot program period with an option to cancel the contract at no cost upon completion of the pilot program; and

WHEREAS, the attached Services Agreement with Flock Group, Inc. has been reviewed and approved by Corporate Counsel.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Berrien County Board of Commissioners authorizes and directs the Chairman of the Board and the County Clerk to execute said agreement between Berrien County and Flock Group, Inc. for a 60-day pilot camera program.
