**TO THE HONORABLE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BERRIEN COUNTY, MICHIGAN:** Your County Administration Committee respectfully recommends the adoption of the following:

**RESOLUTION**

**WHEREAS**, via resolution #A2204243, the Berrien County Board of Commissioners accepted up to \$620,959.66 in grant funds from the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (“MDHHS”) to reimburse the County for expenses related to COVID-19 testing at the Berrien County Jail for inmates, staff, and visitors; and

**WHEREAS**, the grant timeframe was from October 1, 2021 thru June 30, 2022; and

**WHEREAS**, on July 5, 2022, Berrien County was notified that the window for submitting for reimbursement was extended through September 30, 2022

**WHEREAS**, the Berrien County Sheriff’s Office still has expenses that fall within the reimbursable category.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED** that the Berrien County Board of Commissioners acknowledges that the grant period accepted via resolution #A2204243 has been extended through September 30, 2022 and authorizes the Sheriff’s Office to submit reimbursement requests for COVID related testing that occurs at the Berrien County Jail through that deadline.
