

TO THE HONORABLE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BERRIEN COUNTY, MICHIGAN: Your County Administration Committee respectfully recommends the adoption of the following:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, numerous traffic crashes have occurred at the intersection of Hollywood Road and Linco Road in Royalton Township due to the conditions found to exist at that intersection; and

WHEREAS, over the years, the Berrien County Road Department has made signage improvements (cross-road does not stop) and added stop lines, however, the numerous crashes continue; and

WHEREAS, the Berrien County Road Department conducted a traffic study at the intersection due to the number of crashes occurring; and

WHEREAS, the study revealed that the intersection has met requirements for a multi-way stop as found in Part 2 of the Michigan Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Berrien County Board of Commissioners, in accordance with Part 2 of the Michigan Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices, authorizes the Berrien County Road Department to install signage indicating a four-way stop at the intersection of Hollywood Road and Linco Road in Royalton Township.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the signage will be erected and maintained in conformity with the Michigan Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices.
